PAG-02 National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System

- Federal Permit Delegated to Pennsylvania
- General or Individual
- Required for Earth Disturbance Activities that discharge to Surface Waters
- Application Package
- About Every 5-years DEP Revises Permit

Changes to PAG-02 (2009 Amendment)

- Expires in 2 years – PA Chapter 102 Regulation Revisions
 - Federal effluent limitation guidelines
- New Fee
- Renewal application due 180 days before expiration
- Offsite discharges
- TMDL – Total maximum daily loads for impaired waters
- Visual Inspections
- Licensed professional certification after completion
- Clean fill requirements
- Post construction stormwater management requirements
- 537 Sewage planning approval
