- Please check our Website www.wcdpa.com for the most up-to-date WCD Application and Fee Schedules. There are also links to DEP's website.
- Plan Review Status # is what we call the District Review # on the top of all your correspondence for the project. These emails come to Kathy Fritz for her response. You may also email me directly for status at kathy@wcdpa.com

- ***PLEASE MAKE AN APPOINTMENT, IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO MEET WITH OUR STAFF.***
If they are not in when you call and just want to make an appt., please ask for Kathy F. ext. 110 and I will make you an appt.
- Christie enters plans at the reception desk, so she can accept them. If you have questions that she cannot answer, she will refer you to Kathy F.
- Manuals on our website are available to print instantly in your own office. We do not have copies to hand out. Just click on the name below the picture and press print.

Common Mistakes on Plan Submissions

- Plans needed-1 copy of the E&S Plans, drawings & 1 copy of the Stormwater/PCSM Plan, drawings. 3 copies of the NOI only for NPDES permits initially. If we need more copies, we will let you know.
- Correct Address-Westmoreland Conservation District, Donohoe Center, 218 Donohoe Road, Greensburg, PA 15601
- Wrong Fees-refer to our website www.wcdpa.com
- Don't forget to send DEP's \$100 per acre disturbed check payable to Commonwealth of PA Clean Water Fund
- Location of Project (directions)-please make sure this is complete. Our staff uses these directions to get to the site.
- Location Maps (USGS) Please do not shrink these maps. Make sure the one you use is clear, not blurry.

- Make sure you are filling out the Receiving Waters and Chapter 93 Classification-these determine the type of permit you need.
- 105 General Stream Encroachment permit applications must have the PASPGP-4 Screening Form at the beginning; we cannot accept the old form with PASPGP-2 or 3 on it.
- Don't forget to have the applicant sign and notarize the NPDES NOI!

Chapter 102 E&S Pollution Control Plan Review Fees:

Note: For the complete fee schedules refer to Technical Services on the main menu – Erosion & Sediment Control – The Erosion And Sediment Pollution Control (E&SPC) Program, and Stormwater Management – Stormwater Management Program Fees.

The following fees will be charged by the District for earth disturbance E&S pollution control plan reviews. Fees will be based on the amount of disturbed acres associated with the project. Applications will not be accepted for review without the appropriate fee.

DISTURBED ACRES	FEE
0 – 1.99	\$315.00
2 – 4.99	\$470.00
5 – 9.99	\$625.00
10 – 14.99	\$785.00
15 – 19.99	\$940.00
20 – 24.99	\$1,095.00
25 – 29.99	\$1,250.00
